MINUTES

I. CALL MEETING TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order at 10:05 and Donald Goree said a prayer. Board members in attendance were Chairman Roger Bazile, Renisha Hebert, Monica Goree, Estelita Baptiste, Donald Goree, Shannon Jenkins & Roger Johnson. A quorum was determined.

Also, participating were Larry Galloway, Robyn Grant, Wanda Johnson, Charlotte Claiborne, Alvin Claiborne, Damarcus Ledet and Jennifer Ledet

A. Public Comment

Mr. Bazile opened the meeting by asking if any members of the public wished to comment. Larry Galloway spoke about a crime incident in the neighborhood in which a neighbor's dog was shot by a robber. He also encouraged us to be vigilant about watching out for strange behaviors and people. Charlotte Claiborne asked about how we could give citations to people parking on the lawn. Robyn Grant raised a concern about people not cutting their lawn. She also suggested that any literature that we use be printed in both Spanish & English to ensure that we communicated with all residence. After comments were heard, Mr. Bazile proceeded with the meeting.

B. Mr. Bazile reviewed the minutes from the CPID meeting held on December 16th, 2023. On a motion by Roger Johnson and a second by Estelita Baptiste, the minutes from the CPID meeting held on December 16, 2023, were unanimously approved,

C. Treasurer Report

Estelita Baptiste gave a financial report which included the beginning balance of \$28,912.09 less expenses (15,215.05) which leaves an ending balance of \$13,697.04. We currently have \$2889.00 in savings.

Also, the 2024 budget is not completed but will be posted on the website shortly

D. Old Business

A. For Discussion: Update on CPID check/legislature (10K)

Mr. Bazille reported that we did receive our 10K grant from Cleo Field's

office in which we used 9K for the Flock Camera. The unused amount of 1K was placed in savings to use next year towards our Flock Camera bill. The grant is for camera usage only.

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- B. For Discussion: 2ND location for Marquee
Estelita Baptiste is still researching prices & waiting to hear back from one of the vendors for the second Marquee.
- C. For Discussion: Gas Line for Subdivision
Estelita Baptiste received a price of \$1,000 per family for a Gas Line. Charlotte Claiborne recommended that we speak with Rowday Gaudet before we move forward to see if he can provide some assistance.
- D. For Discussion: Curb Addresses signs
We still plan to move forward with the Curb Addresses for safety reasons. Mr. Bazile plans to check with one more company to make sure we are getting the best rate.
- E. New Business
 - A. Landscaping quotes
Mr. Bazile and Estelita Baptiste agreed to look for vendors to give us a quote on cutting Patricia Aguillard's lawn, keeping up the flower bed and keeping the sign clean. They will plan to report their findings at the next meeting.
 - B. Informational safety\social event.
Renisha Hebert discussed having a "Safety Day" on Saturday, April 20th, 2024 at the BREC Ben Burge park from 10:00-2:00PM. The purpose would be to engage our community with safety tips. We will setup booth and invite the sheriff's department, councilman Rowdy Gaudet, fire department & someone to give tips on how to use the 311 services. In addition, we will have food and fun games for the kids. A motion was made by Mr. Bazile to move forward with the Safety Day and seconded by Monica Goree and were unanimously approved. Renisha agreed to chair the committee. Mr. Bazile, Robyn Grant & Demarcus Ledet agreed to assist.

With no further business to conduct, a motion was made by Donald Goree to adjourn the meeting and seconded by Renisha Hebert, the CPID meeting was adjourned at 10:49.
