A. Call to Order

The meeting was called to order at 10:05 by Chairman Roger Bazile and Parliamentarian -Donald Goree said a prayer. Board members in attendance were Chairman- Roger Bazile, Vice-President Alvin Claiborne, Secretary- Monica Goree, Treasurer- Estelita Baptiste, Parliamentarian-Donald Goree, Member- Shannon Jenkins. A quorum was determined.

B. Public Comment:

Larry Galloway discussed possible flooding in our subdivision flooding due to the construction project behind Sagefield. He suggested that residents and board members attend a planning commission meeting to voice our concerns.

C. Approval for Minutes notes from August 16th, 2025:

Donald Goree motioned to approve the minutes as read & it was second by Alvin Claiborne. The floor was open for discussion & there was none. A vote was taken, and the minutes were approved unanimously.

D. Treasurer Report

Monica Goree motioned to approve the treasurer's report as read & it was second by Alvin Claiborne. The floor was open for discussion & there was none. A vote was taken, and the report was approved unanimously.

E. Beautification Committee Report:

The committee would like to change the signage at the front entrance to metal and add an additional marquee to the back entrance. The total for this project is estimated at \$2800 which would include the labor for the front but not the lettering. We will still need to purchase the lettering from another company.

F. Safety Committee Report

Roger Bazile stated that a light was out on Crandon and Donald agreed to report the outage to 311.

G. Old Business

- A. Sheriff Detail in Neighborhood –Since our funds are low and crime is minimum in our subdivision. We agreed not to pursue a sheriff detail at this time.
- B. Since Ben Burge may potentially close, we decided to continue meeting at the library.

H. New Business

I. Vote On New Budget

Shannon Jenkins made a motion that we accept the budget, Roger seconded. The floor was open for discussion- Monica questioned if the price for possible edging the right of way should be included in the 2026 budget and the answer was no. There was no further discussion. A vote was taken and approved unanimously.

J. Vote on New Council for Sagefield CPID (Cedric Upshaw)

Estelita motion that we use Cedric Upshaw as our legal counsel, Donald seconded. The floor was open for discussion and Charlotte recommended that Cedric only speak with 2 officers. The board decided that all our legal questions will go through President and Vice President. There was no further discussion. A vote was taken and approved unanimously. Cedric Upshaw is Sagefield's New Council.

K. For Discussion: Moving Meetings to Tuesdays instead of Saturdays and combining with HOA.

Charlotte Claiborne stated that they want to discuss this with the HOA before deciding to move & combine meetings. At this time, the CPID will continue meeting at the library on Saturday mornings. Roger Bazile will set up meeting dates for 2026.

L. For Discussion Prize Fund for Christmas Lighting Contest

Roger suggested a monetary prize for the Christmas Light contest and said that he will talk with the HOA about assisting with prizes.

M. Adjourn

Alvin made a motion we adjourn the meeting, and it was seconded by Donald. A vote was taken and approved unanimously. The meeting adjourned 11:10.
